A painting representing the dreams and aspirations of people supported by Anchor House in Canning Town is now being auctioned.

It was put together by 12 current and former residents of the home and the artist Stephanie Lai.

Proceeds from the sale of the artwork will go towards CAFOD, the Catholic aid agency which provides aid to those in poverty overseas.

The money will also help provide scholarship for the Anchor House residents. The organisation provides rehabilitation and education to get homeless people back on their feet.
